

**Reference to prohibition of care as set out in section 20 paragraph 9 clause 6 of the German Infection Protection Act**

Dear Parent or Guardian,

The Act on Protection against Measles and Strengthening Vaccine Prevention (The Measles Protection Act) from 10 February 2020 (BGBl. I p. 148) came into force on 1 March 2020. Everyone born on or after 1 January 1971, who are to be provided for the first time with care in a communal facility, such as a school, on or after 2 March 2020 must provide proof of measles vaccination protection, immunity or medical contraindication before starting the care.

In our letter from \_\_\_\_\_ (insert date), you were advised that without submitting the required proof, your child may not be cared for in the pre-school class as set out in section 20 paragraph 9 clause 6 of the German Infection Protection Act. The required proof has not been provided to date.

Please let us know if you are no longer interested in a pre-school place.
